Course description:

This course helps student's gain an understanding of the business/marketing principles necessary to start and operate a business. They will develop an awareness of the opportunities for small business ownership and develop the planning skills needed to open a small business. Students will explore the traits and characteristics of successful entrepreneurs. Students gain an awareness of knowledge needed in research, planning, operations, and regulations affecting small business. They will learn strategies of business management and marketing and the economic role of the entrepreneur in the market system. Entrepreneurship is designed for students enrolled in marketing, business, and/or other courses who have an interest in developing the skills, attitudes, and knowledge necessary for successful entrepreneurs. Students taking entrepreneurship are encouraged to join the DECA and/or FBLA organizations.

Deadlines:

It is expected that assignments will be turned in on time (please note that field trips and athletic competitions are considered school activities and all assignments due on that day should be turned in prior to the student leaving campus for the activity).

Tests & Quizzes:

Test and Quizzes will be given throughout the quarter on the dates specified in the class calendar/syllabus. Tests are to be given on the date specified. All students not excused for that day will NOT have the opportunity to take the test. All excused students will take the test or quiz on the day they return to class. Students will have 1 chance to retake each quiz and test. The retake must be taken within one week of the original test. Retakes will be scheduled for before school or after school at the student's request.

The final exam at the end of the semester will be a comprehensive exam of all material covered during the course. The test will be given only on the date specified on the syllabus. Please contact the instructor immediately if a student will be absent on the day of the test.

Cheating:

Cheating or copying will not be tolerated. If students are involved in this practice they, in turn, will receive an "F" on their assignment without the opportunity to redo the assignment. Cheating can lead to failing the class. (Be Honest)

Parent Notification:

In the unlikely event that a student is receiving a failing grade the following notifications to students, parents and administration will be given.

1. Each term students will be notified by a personal consultation with me the first time a student receives a failing grade.
2. Phone notification and/or E-mail will also be used to notify parents about students failing grades if student is receiving a failing grade with 2 weeks before midterm or the end of the term.

Student Consultation:

Students will meet often to review grades, assignments, expectations and concerns. Extra Credit:

Extra Credit will be allowed, at the discretion of the instructor, but will be strictly limited to projects or assignments that enhance academic learning in the subject. Extra credit will not be accepted in lieu of regular class assignments. Scores earned on vocational competency tests will be calculated into student grades; however, extra credit will be given to students earning a score above 80 percent on the vocational competency test administered in that subject area.

Attendance:

Regular attendance is important in order to be a successful student. If a student is absent (excused), she/he will have one day to make-up assignments missed. If a project was due on the date of the excused absence, the project is due the day the student returns to class. If the excused absence is prolonged, make an appointment to discuss deadlines for work missed upon return to school. If a student is absent and it is unexcused, she/he will not be able to complete the assignment for any points.

Also, bellwork will be given at the beginning of each class period. If a student is absent or late, the bell work cannot be made up.
